'Slicker Shy', the City's bronze sculpture which resided in front of City Hall for many years as a public art piece, is being removed within the next few days. Brenda Crawford suggested the need to work with the highway department to decorate the expanded highway with public art to represent the history of Lewisville. She also recommended a piece of Walt Garrison's carvings as the first piece of donated art to the City. Mr. Garrison is a fantastic speaker who is very fond of Lewisville. Jim Wear advised the Board to establish criteria for coming up with selection of public art to recommend to Council. The Board discussed ideas to come up with a public art vision statement to determine the goal of the public art purpose. This statement should be empowering and representative of the history of the city. Brenda Crawford will write the above mentioned vision statement to present to the Board at the next meeting.
