

PUBLIC NOTICE: The City of Lewisville is soliciting public comment on the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Annual Action Plan to be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for receipt of funds for 2011-2012. The document is available for viewing from 5:00 p.m., Friday, June 17, 2011 until 5:00 p.m. Monday, July 18, 2011 at 151 W. Church St., Economic Development and Planning Division and at the reference desk of the City Library. The Annual Action Plan includes amendments to CDBG-R (Recovery Act) projects. Public Hearing

The 2007 Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development requires an Annual Action Plan (AAP) outlining the CDBG program activities that the City proposes to carry out in the coming year. The City is soliciting input from residents. Comments received during this period will be considered before final approval at a public hearing to be held before the City Council on Monday, July 18, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. at the Old Town City Hall, 151 W. Church St. A public hearing will also be held before the Community Development Block Grant Committee on Tuesday, July 5, 2011 at the same address.

2011 Action Plan Summary

The City of Lewisville will receive \$537,942 in Federal CDBG funding and will add an estimated \$170,000 in City Social Service Agency funding. Additionally, \$180,000 of unspent CDBG funds from prior years is being re-allocated. The total Grants Budget is \$887,942. Social Services distribution: Children's Advocacy Center \$21,750, Christian Community Action \$22,950, Health Services of N. Texas \$2,850, PediPlace \$51,975, Communities in Schools \$30,250, CASA \$11,340, Friends of the Family \$18,900, RSVP \$8,050, SPAN Inc. \$18,900, Day Stay for Adults \$7,550, Operation Peace of Mind \$6,400, Salvation Army \$2,350, Youth & Family Counseling \$40,800, Camp Summit \$1,900, and New Hope Learning Center \$4,725. CDBG funds will also be spent on the following Housing and Community Development Projects: Day Stay Patio Installation \$14,248, First-time Homebuyer Program \$100,000, Housing Rehabilitation \$185,000, CCA Family Assistance Center (up to) \$173,918, and CCA 121 Training Room (up to) \$56,500. Projects considered but not funded: Boys and Girls Club of North Central Texas and Catholic Charities of Fort Worth.

Amendment to CDBG-R Recovery Act Allocation Projects

The City received a one-time CDBG allocation from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of \$151,565. The funds were programmed for sanitary sewer replacement on Edwards St. That project is complete with approximately \$43,000 remaining. The remaining funds are proposed to be used as follows:

Planning: \$15,000

Social Services: \$22,700

Minor Housing Repairs: \$5,300
