**C. Review Railroad St. Park Design and Policies**

How much should be charged and how much would be the Consultant's fee? The Board discussed that it might be best to wait until the Park has been open a couple years and we have a good attendance history with successful tournaments before actively pursuing naming rights. The Board will review this again after the first of the year.

**D. Reports**

*Report on Trails*

Bob Monaghan gave a presentation showing the Fox Creek and Timber Creek Trails. The Fox Creek trail currently connects Raldon Park with Central Park and

bids were recently opened for the construction of the Timber Creek trail from Central Park to Memorial Park. Bob also discussed plans to extend the trail from Memorial Park through the Reserve at Timber Creek subdivision to the existing trail at Hedrick Estates Park. A small playground is also planned for the greenbelt adjacent to Shadowridge. Citizens were in attendance to voice their concerns about the trails and planned playground that are planned to go in close to their homes on the Timber Creek Greenbelt. Bob explained how all the trails will connect and talked about the Park and Open Space Master Plan that was updated in 1998 with a plan for a trail in this location. All Board members present agreed that next month's meeting should be a Public Meeting format to be held in the Community Room. This will allow all concerned residents to attend to gain more information and express any concerns.

Wayne Pickett reported on the Return to Lake Park Concert that was held Sat, October 6, 2007. Due to the rain, attendance was small but the bands were all very good. Seniors are having a great time playing "Pickle Ball" and it seems to be the sports of seniors.
