The City of Lewisville requires registration for your pets. You may submit your pet's City registration in person or by mail.

The registration fee per pet is \$5 for one year for sterilized pets or \$25 for non-sterilized pets, or \$15 for three years for sterilized pets or \$75 for non-sterilized pets. (Proof of sterilization must be provided.)

In Person: Please bring proof that your pet has a valid rabies vaccination (rabies requirements below) and proof of sterilization to the Lewisville Animal Shelter and Adoption Center located at 995 East Valley Ridge Blvd.

By Mail: Please mail proof that your pet has a valid rabies vaccination (rabies requirements below), proof of sterilization (if applicable), and payment to:

Rabies Vaccination Requirements: All dogs, cats, and ferrets that are four or more months of age are required to be vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian. The initial (very first) rabies vaccination your pet receives is valid for one year. Rabies vaccinations received by your pet after the initial vaccination are valid for one year or three years depending upon the type of vaccine your veterinarian used. Please be sure the type of vaccine used by your veterinarian is indicated on your vaccination certificate.

-A permit fee is \$25 or an Urban Chicken Permit fee is \$10. Contact our office with any questions.
