

ARTICLE V. INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS

Section 11-06. Inspection Requirements.

A. INSPECTIONS. All signs for which a permit is required shall be subject to inspection.

1. Footing inspections may be required for all signs having footings.
2. All signs containing electrical wiring shall be subject to the provisions of the governing electrical code, and the electrical components used shall bear the label of an approved testing agency.
3. The Building Official may order the removal of any sign that is not maintained in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.
4. All signs may be re-inspected at the discretion of the Building Official.

B. ENGINEERING CERTIFICATION. An engineering certification is required at the time of permit application to verify the location of any sign in the I-35 E. Corridor. Final inspection and approval of any sign will not be accepted without a second engineering certification, dated after the erection of the sign, giving a final verification of the location of the sign.
