The Old Town Lewisville Post Office, located at 320 S. Charles Street, has served the east side of this community for many years. Many local residents and businesses maintain post office boxes in this facility and conduct their mailing business there. In addition, residents who live in other parts of our city often use this location because of its efficient service and convenience which brings many people to the Old Town area of Lewisville. For all of these reasons, I believe it is important that the Postal Service continue its operations in Old Town.

I understand that the current post office is located in a leased facility and that the lease is occasionally subject to a renewal decision. Even if the Postal Service needs to consider some new location in Old Town that is more cost effective, this would be preferable to simply shutting service off. By maintaining a presence in Old Town Lewisville, the current service level would be maintained and the needs of many people met. The City of Lewisville has spent a great deal of money to revitalize this area and it is considered by many to be the heart of our community. The offering of basic conveniences, such as postal service, is critical in these revitalization efforts, which include the creation of much more housing and business activity, especially as commuter rail service begins nearby in a few years. These efforts will also increase demand for postal services in the area.

I urge you to do what you can to maintain postal service in Old Town Lewisville. Your assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated.
