DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE:

The City Council directed at the 2011 Planning Retreat that staff take the steps necessary to hold a November 2011 election for voter consideration of a one-eighth percent sales tax to support a Crime Control and Prevention District and a one-eighth percent sales tax to support a Fire Control, Prevention, and Emergency Medical Services District. In the creation of both of these districts, state law requires the appointment of a temporary seven member board that is responsible for the development and adoption of a two-year fire/crime control plan and a two-year budget plan. Once these plans are approved by the boards, the temporary boards are then responsible for ordering the election. While each one of the districts must have a temporary board, the same people can be appointed to the two boards. Joint meetings of the two boards are being held for development of the two plans.
