





HOW WE DETERMINED WHAT TO INCLUDE IN A MAKERSPACE?

Research

- Visited library and community makerspaces
- Spoke with staff and makers
- Surveyed library makerspaces

Community feedback – dot voting at two major library events

Makerspace Mission Statement helped drive goals and service priorities

Patron feedback and observation

- Examples – Patrons use study rooms as recording studios, extreme popularity of crafting, sewing, robotics and technology classes
