

City of Lewisville Irrigation System Inspection Credit Guidelines & Instructions

Irrigation systems experience wear and tear with use, and due to the exposure of heads and other working parts of the system, residents are encouraged to have their systems inspected for pressure and performance issues as well as leaks and poorly positioned heads. Residents obtaining an irrigation system inspection from a licensed irrigation professional and subsequently making adjustments to the system that were recommended by the inspection can qualify for a credit on their water bills. Irrigation system inspection credits are available once per fiscal year.

General Guidelines:

- Program applicant must be a water customer of the City of Lewisville in good standing.
- This program is not for multi-family or commercial water customers.
- The City does not endorse any licensed irrigation professional nor is responsible for the performance of the inspection or repair of the irrigation system.
- Funding for each fiscal year runs from October 1 through September 30. A dated and itemized sales receipt must be submitted with the application within sixty (60) calendar days of purchase and installation and postmarked no later than September 15.
- Program terms and conditions are subject to change without prior notification.
- A maximum of \$375 in credits for any combination of eligible water conservation improvements are available per single-family residential address in one fiscal year.

Specific Guidelines:

- Up to a \$50 credit for a qualifying irrigation system inspection.
- One (1) qualifying inspection credit per household.
- To qualify, the irrigation system inspection must be performed by a licensed irrigation professional registered with the City of Lewisville. A [list of Registered Contractors](#) can be found online (right click to open in new tab).

Irrigation System Inspection Credit Instructions

- 1) Look up a licensed irrigation professional registered with the City of Lewisville.
- 2) Contract with the professional for an inspection of the irrigation system.
- 3) Pay and obtain a receipt for the inspection.
- 4) Make any adjustments recommended by the inspection.
- 5) Submit an application with the supporting documentation enclosed (see below).

- Copy of original invoice or sales receipt of the inspection showing date and place of sale.
- Copy of original irrigation inspection report conducted by qualifying professional.
- Copy of original invoice or sales receipt of the goods or services purchased to make the adjustments recommended by the inspection.
