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Temporary Food Establishments Policy and Permit Requirements

The following temporary food establishment policy and guidelines are used to determine if food may be served at an event.

1. All applicants who would like to prepare food at a temporary event must first make application to the Special Event Committee.
2. Upon review by the Special Event Committee it will be determined if food service will be allowed.

Temporary food establishment permits are granted for Special Events. Refer to (Ordinance # 666-1-93).

Allowable Events:

Temporary food service events are:

- Parades, fairs, festivals, exhibits, block parties, street dances, carnivals, circuses, temporary commercial out-door amusements and sporting events.

Temporary Food Establishments May Include:

One (1) grand opening event, or a charity sponsored function, or a U.S. nationally observed holiday. An additional three (3) events may be included throughout the year for a total of six (6) temporary food service events.

City Sanctioned events are exempt.

Time Period Between Uses:

No permit will be issued before 60 days has passed between each event.

Location:

A location may not have more than six (6) temporary food establishment events per year.

Applicant:

An applicant will not be issued more than six (6) temporary establishment food vendor permits per year.
