Plano programs support affordable homeownership by providing down payment and closing cost assistance for low- to moderate-income first time homebuyers. Frisco supports Workforce housing for first time homebuyers. The amount of the assistance is dependent on the homebuyer's income. The program is funded with annual entitlement grants called Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development or specific city grants. Potential homebuyers must complete an application, go for an interview, receive 1 on 1 counseling, and attend one of the above listed classes.
