



**Welcome Dancers!**

We are so excited to be able to have you back in class twirling, tapping and jazzing it up! After the unexpected “intermission” during the Spring of 2020, we are very much looking forward to being able to reopen and offer dance classes again at the MCL Grand! For the safety of all dance families, DanceArts Staff, members of the public and the MCL Grand and THRIVE staff, there are many new protocols being put into place and some restrictions we will be outlining with this document. We are confident that by working together to adhere to these protocols a safe space will be made for all participants.

## **Facility Information and COVID Procedures**

### **What does this mean for the facilities at the MCL Grand?**

At this time we must default to **6-ft social distancing** guidelines set forth by the CDC. Lobby chairs will be spaced accordingly and we ask that you please do not move them from their original place. At this time, observers will not be allowed inside the room during class and any chairs inside, for dancers, will also be spaced 6-ft apart.

The MCL Grand will establish a single consolidated, ADA accessible, checkpoint through which anyone entering the facility will receive temperature checks in accordance with City policy. All other entry points will be locked, and signage will be posted to encourage entry through the designated entry point. *MCL Grand staff may open an additional ADA accessible entry point if necessary.*

Please see the attached map that outlines parking locations and entry point. Parking is available in any of the blue areas and you will follow the yellow arrow to the courtyard entry point.

### **City Requirements for temperature checks and face coverings or masks inside the MCL Grand:**

Everyone in your party MUST undergo a temperature screening. These checks will be facilitated by MCL Grand or THRIVE staff. **If anyone in your party is found to have a temperature greater than 100.4 (average, after 3 attempts), no one from your party will not be permitted further into the building.**


**Face-coverings or masks are required for patrons (10 years old and over) in all public spaces until further notice.** Public spaces include the lobby, restrooms, hallways and Art Gallery. Once dancers are safely inside the classroom, in the required socially distanced manner, they will be allowed to remove their mask or face-covering if they choose. Masks or face-coverings must be reapplied when leaving the classroom to move about the venue or to exit.

### **Safety measures taken by the MCL Grand and THRIVE staff:**

- The MCL Grand will have touchless hand sanitizer stations available in the lobby.
- The MCL Grand will have complimentary face coverings available for any persons who may arrive at the facility without one.

- All MCL Grand and THRIVE staff will wear a face covering in accordance with policies and directives outlined by the City of Lewisville.
- Staff will do a sanitizing sweep of all equipment inside event spaces before the start of classes.
- Staff will prepare common spaces within the facility to allow for appropriate social distancing measures, using various methods which may include signage, physical distancing markers and other measures as needed.
- Daily sanitization regimens are being executed in all common areas and touchable surfaces of the facility, including restrooms, handrails, countertops, vending machines, and available lobby seating.
- Throughout the duration of events MCL Grand staff and custodial staff will walk the building and sanitize all exterior and interior door handles that are currently in use, as well as other common surfaces in the lobby.
- Once a class time has concluded, Staff will sanitize all spaces and equipment utilized during the event (mics, podium, tables, chairs, projector, consoles, etc.) in preparation for the next use of the space.

## 2020- 2021 DanceArts Center Program Information

Classes for the 2020-2021 Season will meet on Mondays & Tuesdays and begin on Tuesday September 8<sup>th</sup>. All classes are held inside the Recital Hall of the MCL Grand (unless otherwise stated).

### **Payment information:**

***Tuition payments must be paid on or before the first lesson day of the month in order for the dancer(s) to be able to participate in the class.***

Payments may be made online through your Amilia account or in person at the MCL Grand on the first lesson of each month. You may pre-pay on the last lesson of the month for the following month.

Tuition prices will remain the same September through May. There is no reduction for missed lessons.

There will be additional fees for the annual recital (due in March) and costume (due in November), which will be paid to DanceArts Center directly.

### **Attendance:**

Regular attendance is very important so that the dancer can gain the most from their lessons. Excessive absences and tardiness hold everyone back. We hope that each student will be on time and attend every class with the exception of "illness" or "family emergency". Makeup lessons will be available in case of illness or emergency from September through March ONLY. No makeup classes will be available in April or May because we will be preparing for our Recital.

### **Required Dance Attire and Shoes:**

**Please label all shoes and dance bag with child's first and last name.**

Pre School Students: Leotard and tights (any color), pink leather ballet shoes and black slip on tap shoes. NO SKIRTS OR TUTUS ARE ALLOWED IN THE DANCE ROOMS.

\*\*\*Please replace the ribbons on tap shoes with black elastic as it enables the child to slip the shoes on by themselves.

School age Students: DAC DANCE TEES with tights and black dance shorts, tan slip on jazz shoes, pink leather ballet shoes and a black lace up jazz tap shoe (BLOCH #SO381).

Male Students: solid color shorts and t-shirt, black slip on jazz shoes and black lace up tap shoes.
