LPD enhanced patrols August 2020

The City of Lewisville and the Denton County Fresh Water Supply District 1-A have an agreement to expand Lewisville Police Department services in Castle Hills.

Each month, we will update those enhanced patrols.

During August, LPD worked 496 hours in Castle Hills, responding to 416 calls for service. Officers made 134 traffic stops, which resulted in 5 citations. August's average response time to Castle Hills was 6.72 minutes. Citywide response times averaged 5.89 minutes.

The highest number of service calls (84) was for Close Patrols. Close Patrols are requested by a homeowner during periods of absences.
